

Licensing, Ins. & Permits

Each vendor must have the required information below in their possession on the day of the Street Festival

UBI number:

Unified Business Identifier refers to a State of Washington business license number. To obtain a UBI, go to: www.dol.wa.gov/forms/700028.html, call (360) 594-4840 or visit the Dept. of Revenue at 1904 Humbolt St. Ste. A in Bellingham.

Certificate of Insurance:

Vendors must provide the Festival with a Certificate of Insurance, by August 12, 2011 naming the Ferndale Chamber of Commerce as additional insured's as pertains to your participation in the Ferndale Street Festival.

Health Department permits and Food Handlers Card:

Health Department permits for food/food product booths are the responsibility of the vendor. For more info go to: www.co.whatcom.wa.us/health/index.jsp

Cancellation Policy:

Cancellation must be received by August 12th for a refund. After that date fees are non-refundable. No exceptions.

Any vendor in non-compliance the day of the festival will not receive a refund and may be asked to leave.

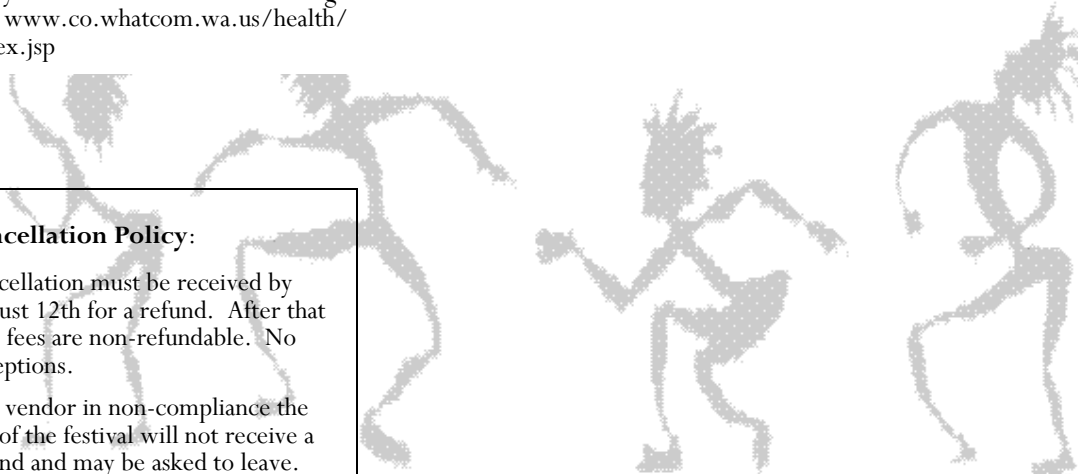

What is the Festival?

The Ferndale Street Festival which draws over 10,000 people kicks off Friday evening with music, food and a beer garden and then all day Saturday with more music & entertainment, a classic car show, kids stage & activities, arts & craft vendors, a beer garden along with numerous other entertaining things to do for the whole family.

Friday: Section of Second Avenue will be shut down for the food vendors, beer garden and music stage.

Saturday: Sections of Main Street & Second Avenue will be shut down at 6 am. Vendors may arrive to set up between 7 and 8 am.

The Festival will begin Friday at 6pm and Saturday at 10am, it will continue into the evening with a wide assortment of entertainment and music for people of all ages to enjoy along with a street dance from 6-11pm. The festival will come to a close at 11 pm Saturday and all streets will reopen. The craft vendor area closes at 6pm with all vendors needing to be off of Main Street by 7pm.

This year the vendors are a block away from the Main Stage as to not have the interference experienced with noise.



Vendor Fees and Categories:

FOOD VENDOR (No hot dog vendors) Fri/Sat . \$75

CRAFT VENDOR Saturday \$60

Non-profit/Service Organization \$40

Power: Add \$25 if power is requested (only allowed one 110 amp). If you require power, you must supply at least 30 ft of electrical cord.

Please provide a photo of your set up booth if you have not attended before. This info helps us with festival layout.

Ferndale Chamber Members will have first priority through February. All past vendors will be eligible to apply in March and all new vendors will be eligible in April. Due to the growing size we reserve the right to have duplicate vendors.

The above prices purchase you a 10x10 space for the entire festival. Each vendor must bring their own tent. Each area must be self contained and unless approved, there are no vehicles allowed in the festival area. If a vendor needs more than a 10x10 space, additional spaces must be purchased. (No exceptions)

Vendors are required to supply their own water if needed.

Vendor location:

A confirmation email letter will be sent *close to the festival date* that includes your booth number and a festival layout map.

Any vendor not in compliance with the above said rules will not be allowed to join the festival.
